### Fun facts about the Queen

Queen Elizabeth II was born at 2.40 a.m. on 21 April 1926 (0)\_\_\_ parents the Duke and Duchess of York, who later became King George VI and Queen Elizabeth (the Queen Mother). She was crowned Queen on 2 June 1953 (1)\_\_\_ by a TV audience of 20 million people. She is the longest reigning monarch (2)\_\_\_ in Britain, beating even Queen Victoria (her great-great-grandma!).

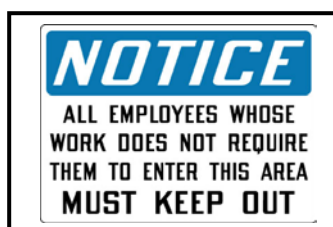
